



The Department of Civil Engineering was established in 1995 with the aim of producing well-qualified graduate engineers capable of meeting the changing and ever expanding needs of the country. The total enrolment in the 4-year B.Sc. Engineering degree program is about 800. A class size of about 50 students is maintained for effective teaching.

There are now 36 full-time faculty members including five professors, three associate professors, eleven assistant professors and seventeen lecturers. Six faculty members are on leave for higher studies. More full-time teachers will be on board as a general policy of the Department, to enhance the Departments strength in teaching and research.

The Department has established the laboratories with modern equipment on its permanent campus. Process is going on to procure more modern and sophisticated equipment to support teaching and research activities.

The B.Sc. Engineering degree, offered by the Department of Civil Engineering of AUST, is officially recognized by the Institution of Engineers (IEB), Bangladesh. Graduates of the Department have a very good record of employment in various public and private organizations. Many have joined post-graduate studies in Bangladesh (for example at BUET) and other universities in various countries.

Department of Civil Engineering is also offering M.Sc. degree from 2011. The contribution of Civil Engineering Department to the society has enhanced by producing efficient engineers for nations building.
